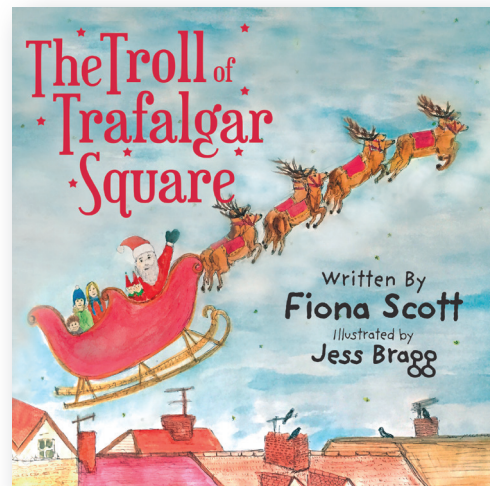
Join Hudson and Anfred on their Christmas Eve journey! Are there trolls living in Trafalgar Square? Will Anfred ever get home?
